

Personal Data Protection Policy

Introduction:

The Financial Regulatory Authority (FRA) and The International Organization of Securities Commissions (IOSCO) value the privacy and confidentiality of the participants in IOSCO event. Please read this policy carefully to understand our practices regarding your privacy.

Information Collection:

Personal Information: For the purpose of the IOSCO 2026 Annual Meeting and FRA Public Conference, we may collect, storage, use, transfer and erasure your personal information, representing, visa information, accompanying persons, flight details, social events, accommodation and any other information you provide during the event. Whether or not by automated means, we will only collect and process such information with your explicit consent and in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

Your Rights Regarding Personal Data:

You have the right to access and to rectify your personal information provided through the registration platform.

Purpose of the data:

We will use the collected information during the event solely for conducting and facilitating the event. Moreover, we may communicate with you before, during, and after the event. This may include sending event reminders, sharing relevant documents or information, and addressing any follow-up questions or inquiries.

During the IOSCO 2026 Annual Meeting and FRA Public Conference, photographs and/or audio-visual recordings might be taken and/or live-streamed. These photos and videos may be published on FRA and IOSCO's website, social media pages, and the online platforms of the co-organizers. They may also be recorded and utilized in various media formats, including FRA and IOSCO's publications, social networks, and press, pertaining to a specific event. By attending such event, you are acknowledging and agreeing that you may appear in publicly available photos and/or videos as described above.

Authorized disclosure:

FRA and IOSCO may disclose the confidential information under certain circumstances to:

- Co-organizers (GCM) of the event as reasonably necessary for the management and organization of the specific event for which you registered;
- Third-party service providers assisting FRA with the specific event, subject to contractually agreed conditions of confidentiality and security; or
- Other third-parties for which you consent to disclosure in connection with the specific event.

The information that is already in the public domain or received from a third party is not within the scope of this policy.

Data Security:

We prioritize the security and protection of your personal information. To ensure this, we employ suitable technical and organizational safeguards to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, or destruction of your data.

Confidentiality:

All employees and third-party service providers who have access to your personal information are required to keep it confidential and use it solely for the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy.

FRA and IOSCO agree to keep the confidentiality of your information and to use it only for the purposes of this event. FRA and IOSCO would take reasonable measures to protect the information from unauthorized access or disclosure.
